Planning Your Trip

What to Pack

The weather this time of year in Nashville ranges in the 70s and 80s, and cooler at night. We recommend packing accordingly, but nights do get cooler if you are going to roam Nashville.

If you have not been to Nashville before, it is important to note there are many area attractions within walking distance, so bring some good walking shoes if you intend to tour the town!

Attire

The general conference attire is business casual. We are encouraging Nashville themed attire for our Day 1 events (Saturday) as tribute to Music City!

Meeting rooms can be cooler, we recommend bringing a sweater or jacket to keep you comfortable.

The Final Night Cocktail Reception and the Dinner & Awards Ceremony will be inside. Many of our attendees enjoy dressing up for the final night events, but wear what you feel most comfortable in.

Broadway, The Main Stripe in Nashville

Known as the "Honky Tonk Highway," Broadway is a major hub for live music, entertainment, and nightlife, making it one of the most popular destinations in the city Broadway stretches for approximately one mile, running perpendicular to the scenic Cumberland River in the heart of downtown Nashville. It is lined with a multitude of honky tonks, restaurants, bars, and shops, each exuding its unique charm and character. The section of the street that contains the honky tonks is from 1st Avenue (next to the river) up to 7th Avenue. It's here the street's iconic neon signs, live music that pours out onto the sidewalks, and the lively atmosphere create an unmistakable energy that has become synonymous with Nashville's music scene.



Getting to the Hotel

There are several options for you to get from the airport to the hotel.

Car Rental

Rent with National or Enterprise Car Rental using the Cobblestone Hotels Code of XZ44440 to get special pricing if available. Parking fees do apply at the hotel, please contact the hotel for more information. The car rental facility can be found next to Terminal Garage 1. You will exit the Main Terminal on Level 1, cross Terminal Drive to Terminal Garage 1 and follow signs to the left for Rental Cars

Ride Share

There is also Lyft and Uber, the pick up for these is at the Ground Transportation Center, Level 1 of Terminal Garage. Lyft picks up at Ride App Zone A; Uber picks up at Ride App Zones & C.

Arriving to the Hotel

Registration

Registration for the conference will be Saturday September 28th, 2024, starting at 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM at the Renaissance Nashville in the Renaissance: Grand Ballroom Foyer. You will find registration at the Cobblestone Hotels booth. There will be signs to help guide you there. Registration will only take place here this year and will not be available at other events. Please be sure to register during this time so access to offsite events is permitted.

Concierge

There is a concierge at the hotel to assist you with any attractions, tours, or tickets to shows.

General Conference Information

It is extremely important that you wear the conference badge you receive at registration to all conference events. Attendees without the badge will not gain access to any events. Renaissance Nashville's security, as well as off-site event staff, will stop you and not allow access unless the badge is visible at all events.
